- Republic Act 7875, as amended, mandatory coverage for all Filipinos
- Universal Healthcare for all Filipinos
- Implemented and managed by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth)
- Overseas Filipinos Program, ensure coverage of Filipinos abroad, documented or not

Membership

- Implementation of RA 10606 otherwise known as the National Health Insurance Act of 2013 - **Mandatory coverage for all Filipinos:**
 - a. Members in the formal economy (*Government and Private Employees, Seabased Migrant Workers*)
 - b. Members in the informal economy (*Migrant Workers, Self-Earning, Professionals and Informal Sector*)
 - c. Lifetime Members (*Pensioners, Retirees*)
 - d. Sponsored Members (*Vulnerable Groups, LGU volunteers, Pregnant Women who are not NHIP members*)
 - e. Indigents (*Poor as identified by DSWD*)

Overseas Filipino Workers (OFW)

Demographic

As of 2010

- OFWs represents 6.9% of the economically active population (20-39 years old)
- Average age of 34.4 years old
- For every 10 Women, there are 11 Men

The Benefits

1. Primary Care Benefits
2. Fixed or case rate payment of at least Php4,600 (or \$107) medical or surgical cases including selected cancer or cardio cases & prosthetics
3. Reimbursement for confinements abroad
4. Other special benefit packages for TB, HIV, etc.
5. Lifetime membership upon retirement at age 60 with payment of 120 months of contribution





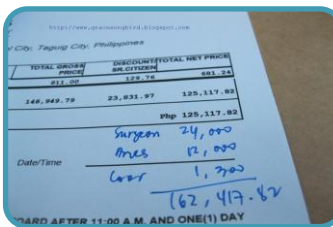
How to Avail the Benefits ?



Accredited Hospital and Professionals (doctor)



PhilHealth Claim Form 1 and Submit supporting Documents for Claims Purposes



Automatic Deduction of PhilHealth Benefits upon Discharge
(*local confinement*)



Confinement abroad is reimbursable based on local benefit payment rate



How to Avail the Benefits ?

Important !!!

Overseas Confinement

- File claims within 180 days upon discharge

Entitlement

- 45 calendar days for the member +45 calendar days to be shared by the qualified dependents
- With valid premium payment prior to confinement



How much is the premium?

Premium for Land Based :

Php2,400.00 or \$55.81 annually

- Payment on an Annual basis
- The amount is equivalent to the premium contribution of the poorest members of PhilHealth

Premium for Seabased :

- Contribution depends on amount salary



Who are covered?



Principal Member including his/her Qualified Dependents:

- Legal Spouse (*not an active member*)
- Children below 21 years old
- Children with mental & congenital conditions regardless of age
- Foster child (ampon)
- Parents 60 years old and above
- Parents with permanent disability
