


LEGAL BASIS



Through the Letter of Instructions (LOI) No. 856, s. 1979, the ECC was mandated to establish and operate a Workers' Rehabilitation Center Complex (WRCC) that would offer comprehensive disability management and rehabilitation services for persons with work-related disabilities (PWRDs) in both the public and private sectors.








The WRCC is a key facility for the implementation of the ECC Disability Management & Return-To-Work Assistance Program (DM-RTWAP) that ensures that our workers receive the support they need to return to work as soon as they are medically ready by utilizing an interdisciplinary approach.

THE WORKERS REHABILITATION CENTER COMPLEX (WRCC)

The WRCC is a key facility for the implementation of the ECC DM-RTWAP that ensures that our workers receive the support they need to return to work by:

- Provide rehabilitation services that address the diverse needs of workers. This may include specialized therapies for gender-specific injuries or illnesses.
- Offer counseling and support services that address the psychological and emotional impact of work-related injuries, taking into account potential gender differences in coping mechanisms.
- Vocational training programs that are not gender biased, and that allow both men and women to have equal opportunities to gain new skills.


